DAY 1: MYSTERY

Main Point // Why does it matter if I sin?

Each of us is a suspect of the worst crime ever committed. We've been caught in the act- sinning against God. Today, we will learn about what sin is and how we are enslaved to it apart from God.

Focus Verse // John 8:34

DAY 2: EVIDENCE

Main Point // How can God forgive all the sins in the world, including mine?

Even with all the evidence stacked against us, we've been judged blameless in God's court because God sent his son to rescue us. That's good news! God sent His son Jesus to pay for our sins through His death on the cross. When we surrender our lives to Him, we get to be in a relationship with God.

Focus Verse // 1 John 1:9

DAY 3: CASE CLOSED

Main Point // How do we have hope in such a broken world?

The world is a very broken place, but we have hope in Jesus! God wants to empower us to be a part of His great rescue plan for the world. God has closed the case once and for all. Our testimony about this great mystery is a tool for good, meant to be shared with the whole world!

Focus Verse // Romans 8:38-39



PACKING LIST

WHAT TO BRING

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Tobacco, drugs, vape pen, or alcohol
- Fireworks, water balloons or weapons
- Skateboards, roller skates or roller blades

CAMP DRESS CODE

- No clothing that reveals undergarments
- No short shorts or skirts
- No speedos or midriff-baring bathing suits
- No clothing with questionable sayings, slogans, etc.
